A meeting will be held on the date and location below to preview the grade-level HIV/AIDS Prevention Education Units.


Date: Tuesday, December 15, 2015

State law provides that a parent or guardian must attend such a meeting before they can object and have their child or ward excused from participation in the HIV/AIDS prevention program.
